1. Future activities of AOCNS and Summer school

AONSA Summer school in 2009 to be held in Australia

The topics of a summer school can be selected by the host society. However the EC recommends that specific topics or general topics should be taken alternatively from one to the next.

> AONSA Summer school in 2010 could be held in India

This is a tentative agreement and it should be discussed and confirmed with the Indian EC members later.

- > AOCNS (Asia Oceania Conference for Neutron Scattering) in 2011 to be held in Japan *Candidate of chairman of this conference will be the next president of JSNS
- > All members should make great efforts to make this conference successful. In discussion it was agreed that there should be a business plan for the conferences.

> AONSA Summer school in 2011 in Japan

*Candidate of chairman will be Prof. Sibayama

- > AOCNS in 2015 could be held in Taiwan, but this should be discussed in the future.
- > ICNS in 2017 could be held in Korea, but this should be also discussed in the future.

2. AONSA Formal Business and Budget

- Agreement at Osaka meeting to put AONSA office in Japan discussed and reaffirmed.
- It was agreed that the next Executive Committee meeting could be held at the AsCA
 meeting in Beijing which is 22-25 October 2009. It was decided that the AONSA
 Executive should meet there on 25-10-2009.
- · At this meeting the next vice-president of AONSA should be elected.

2.1 Budget

- Annual fees to be held at AONSA office at J-PARC.
- Some discussion on AONSA retaining share of profits from AONSA conferences main aim is to "grow the Asia Oceania Society but there will need to be some rules for organizing the conferences"

2.2 AONSA -J-PARC relationships

AONSA -J-PARC relationship needs an officially written agreement.

(AONSA should agree with J-PARC at a high level)

J-PARC needs to show the official agreement for accepting to host the AONSA office.

2.3 General rule

- -The board can make a decision on how to spend the money
- -Main propose of the budget is for supporting travel expenses and registration fees, etc. for young scientists
- Budget plan should be submitted by the AONSA board to the EC a half year before a EC meeting and needs an approval from EC.
- A host association of the Summer school should be allowed to request some budget to AONSA.

2.4 Some questions remain

- > How should we invest our money?
- ► How can AONSA get donations? For example from industry.
- -> Japanese law says that AONSA has to be a formal body, e.g. NPO (according to Japanese law) however it is costly to maintain accounting etc. More information requested and details to be worked out.
- -> AsCA can be a good example. We can ask Prof. Ohashi, ex-president of IUCr
- > Money leftover from contributions and possibly conferences should be deposited to be spent for coming larger meetings.

3. AONSA award

We decided to have the 1st AONSA award at AOCNS in 2011 (every 2 years after that)

Future tasks:

- Should we give awardees money or plate?
- > We should make a special committee to establish the AONSA awarding mechanism.
- ➤ How can we find sponsors?
