**On submission of “the 2nd report on
the radioactive material leak at the Hadron Experimental Facility,
the Japan Proton Accelerator Research Complex (J-PARC)”
and “the accident / failure report”**

In accordance with Paragraph (1) of Article 42 of the Act on Prevention of Radiation Health Impairment Due to Radioisotope, etc. and Paragraph (1) of Article 39 of its enforcement ordinance, the High Energy Accelerator Research Organization (Director General: Atsuto Suzuki) and the Japan Atomic Energy Agency (President: Shojiro Matsuura) submitted the second report on the radioactive material leak at the J-PARC Hadron Experimental Facility” to the Nuclear Regulation Authority today. We also submitted “the accident / failure report” on the same incident to Ibaraki Prefecture, Tokai Village, and other relevant local governments based on the agreement on safety and environmental protection near nuclear facilities.

This report, a follow-up to the first report which was submitted on 31 May 2013, summarizes the issues identified through our investigation so far and our analysis on them up to now. We will continue more detailed investigation toward the final report, which incorporates inputs we seek from external experts.

The English translation of this report will be published in the J-PARC website as early as possible.
