Results of the individual dose measurements from the Radioactive Material Leak at the Hadron Experimental Facility (HD Facility)

J-PARC Center reports that whole body counter measurements carried out on two users from overseas in their home countries showed no sign of radiation exposure as a result of the Radioactive Material Leak at the HD Facility on 23 May 2013.

Below is a summary of the results of the internal and external radiation exposure for all persons who entered the radiation controlled area of the HD Facility after the accident occurred.

- Total number of persons tested for radiation exposure: 102
- Number of persons showing detectable dose: 34
Note: All are radiation registered workers. Individual doses were in the range of 0.1-1.7 mSv.
- Number of persons showing no detectable dose: 68 (including the foreigners above)
