Important note for the conference in RIKEN

This handout includes important information for the conference in RIKEN.

1, Getting IC card "PASMO or SUICA" which can be obtain in airports only

PASMO and SUICA are IC card which can be used as a commuter ticket on railways and buses in the greater Tokyo area. These are very convenient cards, as they can also be used for shopping. To have lunch in the RIKEN cafeteria, PASMO or SUICA are necessary. Credit cards and cash are not available in RIKEN cafeteria.

Due to the difficulties in availability due to shortage of semiconductor and IC chips, PASMO and SUICA can be obtained only in airport and terminal railway stations, currently.


You are strongly recommended to get PASMO or SUICA in NARITA or HANEDA international airport. These cards are available for transport from the airport to RIKEN by train. These cards allow your comfortable train transfer in Japan. Otherwise, you will have to buy tickets for each of the many transfers you make during your Tokyo stay.





Narita Airport Terminal 1 Sta.




Narita Airport Terminal 2, 3 Sta.


Shuttle bus from Haneda Airport to Wakoshi station.



Other shuttle bus from Narita and Haneda Airport to terminal stations "Shibuya", "Shinjuku" and etc. are possible.

To get to Wakoshi Station by train from Ikebukuro or Tokyo area, take the Tobu Tojyo Line, Tokyo Metro Yurakucho Line, or Tokyo Metro Fukutoshin Line bound for "Shinrinkoen", "Kawagoeshi", "Shiki" or "Wakoshi". Trains to other destinations go in different directions on the same line.
